

How to apply for an EHC needs assessment



To make a request for an Education Health and Care (EHC) needs assessment, a request needs to go to the Special Educational Needs (SEN) Service. You will be taken through a series of questions once you click on the tab "checklist for parents and carers". You have to make the request online here:



Click the tile called "Request an EHC needs assessment". You have to go through a checklist but no matter what your answers to these questions, you can still progress to making an EHC needs application.



During the EHC needs application process you will be asked three questions:

What historical information about the child or young person's **special educational needs** is relevant to this request?

What historical information about the child or young person's **health needs** is relevant to this request?

What historical information about the child or young person's **social care needs** is relevant to this request?

After you have submitted your request, you will receive an immediate autoreply to confirm that it has been safely received. You will then receive an email from the Hampshire SEN Service within two weeks, inviting you to register on the EHC Hub. Once you have registered you will be able to upload documents and any other evidence you wish to share with Hampshire SEN on to the hub.

You have been invited to register an account on the Education, Health and Care (EHC) Hub as a parent, carer or guardian. Click the link below (Complete your registration) and you shall be guided through setting up your account.

Registering your account will enable you to view the progress of your EHC case, provide additional information or advice you wish to be considered and view information provided by others involved in your child/ young person's care.

Once your account is successfully registered, please use the following link to access the EHC Hub:

Education, Health and Care Hub

- You may have heard of the 'Our Story', which is the document that was used to capture a parental contribution. This asks for information about:

 a) your child's early years b) their educational progress and learning, c) their friends and relationships, d) their health and wellbeing
- Although this is not requested now, you can still use the template if it helps you to gather your thoughts and views about your child
- Hampshire SENDIASS can provide you with the template and some guidance on completing the Our Story
- If your child or young person would like help with preparing their views about their education, we can offer that support to them.
